

### Costume

HC1. Show us your best costume photo!

For the Obstacle Courses you can use materials you have on hand. Just make sure every obstacle is safe and allows an escape route and fulfills the intended question posed to the pony and rider. Make sure ground poles won't roll if hit or stepped on. If using a tarp for the Varied Footing obstacle make sure the

edges are well secured under the footing of the arena or every edge is secure under a heavy weight. For the flag pick up and return you can use a small bucket full of sand for the flag to "stand" in and a bucket with sand or other weight in the bottom for the flag return. For the Weave cones you can use any safe element (like jump standards etc) that the judge can easily see.
